REPORT OF INSPECTOR.

To His Excellency, ISAAC P. GRAY,
Governor of Indiana:

In compliance with Section 5154 of the Revised Statutes of Indiana, making it the duty of the State Inspector of Oils to make an annual report of all inspections made by himself and deputies to the Governor, I hereby submit the same. I also submit the report for the first three months of the year 1885, under the supervision of Mr. E. H. Swayne, my predecessor in office, as found on the official record.

The quantity of oil rejected in this State during the last year was 1,033 barrels, an excess of over 85 per cent. over any previous annual report, which shows well of the efficiency of the Inspectors employed to protect the public against dangerous and adulterated oils.

On next page I present tabulated statement of oils inspected and fees collected for same by myself and deputies from April 1, 1885, to January 1, 1886. Also, report of E. H. Swayne and deputies from January 1, 1885, to April 1, 1885.
