THE IMPERIAL WIZARD ANSWERS RABBI BOOZE SQUAD IN EVANSVILLE GETTING RESULTS TOLERANCE TAKES THE COUNT AGAIN!

A Lesson to the Jew and a Sane Definition of the Klan's Attitude to the Jewish Race Made by Imperial Wizard H. W. Evans.

Answers a Bitter Attack of Rabbi S. Wise in New York—Remarkable Interview Clearly Defines Klan's Attitude Toward the Jew.

(By Eyewitness)

Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, of international reputation, and among the most prominent Jewish rabbis in the United States, at the Stuyvesant Neighborhood House, Manhattan, N. Y., speaking on the subject, "Jew or American," recently denounced the Klan as un-American, and denounced it as against America, "because they do not know America's soul."

In answer to Rabbi Wise, the fiery Cross has issued a statement from Dr. H. W. Evans, Imperial Wizard of the Invisible Empire, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan. Dr. Evans says: "There seems to be a prevalent impression in some sections that the Klan is hostile to the Jew. This is untrue and is un-American and has not been fostered by the organization."

In order that misunderstandings should not obtain, and that interpretations shall not continue, I shall undertake to discuss candidly and without prejudice the composition and aims of the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, and how the organization, in the maintenance of its principles and purposes, has been fostered by alien forces and un-American elements into an attitude of defense, which has been distorted into an attitude of bigotry and intolerance against certain elements of race, creed and color on the American continent.

"The Order of the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan has been compelled to content, on its own soil, for the right to occupy its inheritance from the first of its birth to the present day. Composed of native-born white, Protestant, Christian Americans, the Order has been challenged to show cause why it should be regarded as inimical and exist for patriotic, fraternal and benevolent purposes."

KLAN WINS IN EAST ST. LOUIS

CANDIDATES MAKE A CLEAN SWEEP.

East St. Louis, Ill., March 9.—The Ku Klux Klan today sweeping victory with the nomination of three candidates for municipal commissioners in the primary held Tuesday.

The victorious candidates are: Rev. William E. Evans, Ralph Cook and August M. Rosenmann. They had the full support of the Ku Klux Klan and the Protestants of their wards. Two candidates who denied support from the Klan lost in the primary. Five commissioners are nominated for the municipal election to be held in April.

Present allusions were made by the opposition to the "Mer Rouge Frisco" and Klan-men retaliated with the circulation of several thousand copies of Col. Mayfield's Weekly, containing a true version of the Louisiana affair.

The story worked like a charm on the starchy citizenry. A Klan endorsement candidate by a Roman Catholic policeman, the Protestant citizenship league arrested and voted as one man for the persecuted candidate.

East St. Louis is one of the strongest Klan centers in the middle section. The order is sweeping the southern part of Illinois with unrivaled rapidity.

for the senate of the United States. "It is presented in the form of a petition protesting against the seating of Earl Mayfield, his associates in Texas on the ground that his election was accomplished by fraud, in violation of the laws of the state...

"There is now not much doubt that the Ku Klux Klan is fairly launched as a political issue and that not only the senate but the major political parties must declare their attitude toward it. The question is of particular moment to the South where the Klan is strong and where naturally, the Democratic party, is the only one affected. Some southern senators who face a campaign in 1921 have been reluctant to take a stand against the Klan...

Charges Against Klan. "In order to obstruct the government of the Constitution and the visible Empire" and in order to consummate the general conspiracy alleged in the petition recites, said Mayfield and his confederates and co-conspirators through the use of natural and artificial means, have procured, organized and conducted various forms of subversion and sabotage, and have enacted and are enacting laws and decrees which are calculated to terrorize and intimidate citizens and classes...

"In and in order to accomplish the ultimate general purposes of the conspiracy the petition recites, the conspirators have procured, organized and conducted various forms of subversion and sabotage, and have enacted and are enacting laws and decrees which are calculated to terrorize and intimidate citizens and classes...

"The petition sets forth that George B. Paddy, Mayfield's opponent, was nominated and elected to the Republican state central committee and endorsed at a mass meeting of independent voters; that he received 175,000 votes, although his name was not printed on the ballot, and that 200,000 were counted, as a result of the conspiracy. It also alleged that Mayfield violated all the moral provisions of the Texas corrupt practices act, and his co-conspirators having perpetrated a number of crimes in the primary election campaign.

THOUSANDS WATCH FRANKFORT PARADE

MORE THAN SIX HUNDRED ROBED KLANSMEN IN PARADE

Special Cars Bring Visiting Members Here Early Last Night for Meeting.

Frankfort, Ind., Feb. 17.—Several thousand persons from over the entire county last night saw the first public demonstration of the Ku Klux Klan ever given in Frankfort when a large parade, estimated to include about six hundred fully robed Klansmen, two hands and several floats, appeared in the business section of the city shortly after ten o'clock. The parade had been previously announced by large advertisements in each of the local newspapers and a great throng of curious citizens had gathered in wait three hours before the appearance of the Klansmen.

The parade was led by two white-robed Klansmen, mounted on white hooded and blanketed horses. An automobile carrying a large electrically lighted trolley followed. The Klansmen were followed by a large bus, which was directly followed by about twenty robed Klansmen. According to a statement given this morning by the Morning Times over the telephone, this flag was attached to a very interesting history. The informant stated that the flag was brought here from Crawfordsville and was carried here by a Klansman during his tour around the world which was made following his term as Grand Dragon of the United States. The flag has been in all of the principal foreign countries.

Several large floats were scattered throughout the parade as were placards on which were displayed the principles of the Klan, "Separation of Church and State," "Law and Order," "Protection of Pure White Blood," and "Justice for Lawless Liberty." A few of the inscriptions seen on the placards.

The parade started from the fairgrounds where a huge tent had been raised in which to hold the initiatory work which had been announced as a conclusion of the demonstration. A large crowd was set ablaze just before the parade left the fairgrounds. The line of march led north on Jackson St. to Washington St., thence west to Main St. and south to the fairgrounds.

Not a word was spoken by any of the Klansmen in the line of march. Klansmen, stationed along the line of march, ordered the crowd back as the parade approached and as the floats passed they were kept from dropping into the line of march. A Klansman with a decorated horse and a Klansman with a white robe and hood, the two lines of marching Klansmen as they passed through the uptown streets.

Klansmen from several nearby cities and towns were said to be among those in the line of march. Four special cars carried Klansmen to this city from Marion, Muncie, Kokomo and Crawfordsville.

A large crowd of citizens followed the parade to the fairgrounds and were allowed to pass within sight of the open end of the tent in which the initiatory work was conducted. Three hundred candidates were said to have been initiated into the organization following the parade.

After making the same presentation speech as he had made before the first congregation the Klan representative handed over the \$2,000 in bills to the Rev. Steffy who accepted it, thanked the Klansman for his appearance there and his organization for the noble support they had given.

Rumors Afloat

Since the Klan has given the necessary funds to complete the year of religious education for Protestant youngsters many comments and rumors have been passed around. Many say that it is the greatest thing ever done by the Klan in any part of the United States and that if that is the type of organization the Klan is the organized press of their enemies have been unjustly persecuting them.

Chief of all the rumors is the strong prediction that the Rev. Steffy will face a much larger congregation on Sunday mornings and that not only Klansmen but sincere Protestants will affiliate with the Pine St. Presbyterian church.

HENRY COUNTY WONDERS, AND SO DO THE LAWLESS

SOME FORCE AT WORK FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

New Castle, March 5.—Liquor law violators in Henry County will begin to think that they were tipped off by radio, so swiftly doth one raid follow another.

Last evening it was John J. Dams, in the town of Hillsboro, three miles northeast of New Castle. Shortly before noon today officers who made a search of the home of Charles Fry, a half mile east of Mt. Summit, made one of the biggest hauls since the famous raid in Liberty township, a few years since. In the basement of the Fry home there were found two sets of bottles and the other of forty gallons capacity; also a full line of accessories.

In addition to the two stills the officers took sixteen gallons of finished liquor, 400 gallons of mash, 550 pounds of granulated sugar, eleven jugs, and two sacks of bottles. The indications pointed to the Fry home as a filling station.

Fry, and all the accessories, except the mash, which was poured out, were brought to the county jail. That other raids, it is probable, are scheduled for the afternoon, was intimated, but not a word was given out as to who, or in what section of the county.

tion. First: That we denounce as underhanded, unprincipled and un-American the Jesuitical propaganda that is being fathered and carried on by a certain secret organization of certain religious sect and given publicity through the daily press.

"Second: That we denounce all such grandstand plays as was pulled off by the chief of police of Springfield, O., Mr. E. O'Brien, in raiding the Klan meeting that was being held in that city.

"Third: That we warn the American Legion that if it draws the line against the Ku Klux Klan, as is proposed by Father O'Connor, the national chaplain, that it may expect the legion to become purely a Catholic and alien organization.

"Fourth: That in reply to the abuses at the 'hood' which certain headline writers seem to have an understanding of, we call the public's attention to the historical fact that every member of the Boston Tea Party was masked, and that every good American thanks God for the Boston Tea Party.

"Fifth: That we express ourselves unreservedly as being against any organization that takes the law into its own hands, but that we do not consider as such, crooked and corrupt officials who enforce the law, taking the law into one's own hands. We consider that a high and meritorious public service.
