## RAILROAD LOADINGS HEAVIER THAN USUAL

Total of 1 035 741 Cars for Week Is Second Highest of Any Like Period on Record

WASHINGTON, D. C., Sept. 4.—
Railroad loadings of revenue freight continue to run the heaviest for this season of the year in the history of the country, according to reports tabulated by the American Railway Association.

During the week-end August 18, a total of 1,035,741 cars were loaded, the second highest total for anyweek on record.


