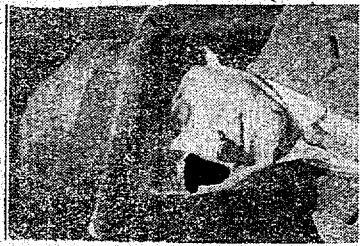

Saturday Evening Post Writer Gives Stirring Answer to "Why the Klan?"

Garret Garrett Shows the Danger Which Threatens America by Continuation of Unrestricted Immigration and Reveals Growing Power of Foreign Politicians Under the Old Regime—Makes No Direct Mention of Ku Klux Order, Adding to Force of Article.

To the question "Why the Klan?" Garret Garrett, a writer in the Saturday Evening Post, has supplied the answer in an article which appeared in that publication in its issue of August 9, entitled "Lo, the Native American." That the article does not at any time refer to the Protestant American organization or to the religious issue only adds to the force of the writer's presentation of a subject that may most properly be designated as one of the chief contributing causes of the rise and ever-increasing growth of the Klan organization.

The Roman corporation, which is the chief champion of unrestricted immigration in this country, has sought with characteristic subtlety to convey to the American people the thought that the Klan's interest in the immigration problem is because it is feared that through immigration Roman Catholics will eventually achieve its boasted aim to "make America Catholic." Garret Garrett, with not a color of sentiment, and probably without a thought of the American organization, most clearly reveals to the American people that the problem is one that must be solved right if America is to survive.

Thoughtful readers will see that the author's main purpose is to be disposed of by foreign friends who have no care or liking for America. But that it is a matter which concerns vitally the real American citizenry of the country the author shows so conclusively and so positively that it is sufficient answer to those who would ask "why the Klan?"

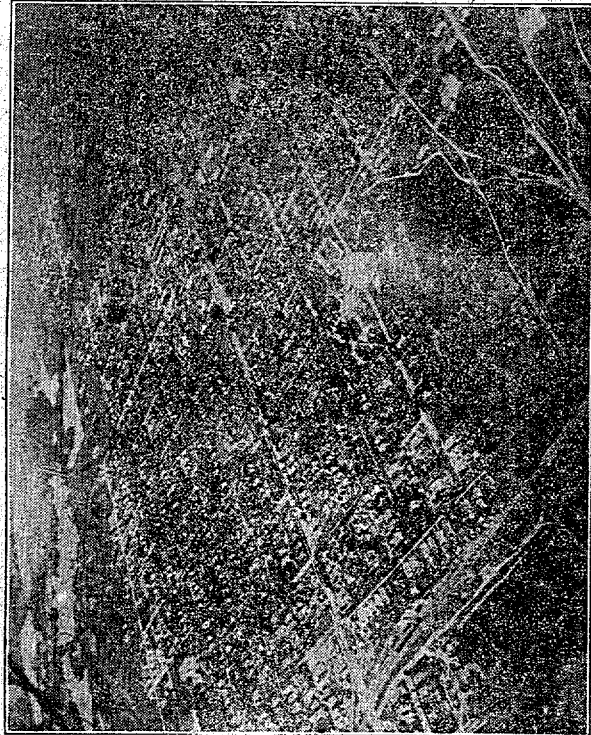
Early Settlers Mostly English. One of the chief reasons for the growth of the Klan organization is given as to why really founded America. The Roman Catholic element is clearly shown to have been a negligible quantity.

In 1790, when the first national census was taken, the population of the United States was 3,929,214. Of this population 1,000,000 were of British origin, about one-sixth of the total. The remainder was of Dutch, German, Irish, French, and other European descent.

Foreign Vote Changes. "As the flood of south and east European immigration changed the racial composition of the population, the vote was changed. ANTI-KLAN VANDALS RUIN G. A. R. SHAFI

Flaming Circle Members Fined for Depredation of Patriotic Monument

KROOK, Ia., Sept. 9.—That the members of the Flaming Circle, an anti-Klan organization, will go to any extent to carry on their activities, is evidenced in a recent case, which has just come to light. A monument to the memory of a prominent citizen of this town, erected on the corner of Main street, in Torrence Post No. 2, Department of Iowa, Grand Army of the Republic, was the subject of a recent case. The bronze tablet on its face bears the significant American inscription: "SACRIFICED FOR HIS COUNTRY AND HIS PEOPLE." Several men, who were more American or more pre-Klan, this evidently aroused the ire of five members of the Flaming Circle and caused them to commit the depredation of which they were later arrested.

Discovered by Klan. An old automobile tire, stuffed with straw and placed against the face of the monument. Not only was the face blackened up, but the concrete base was chipped by the extremists. Members of the Klan, who were alerted by the information, immediately turned the information over to the police, who took action.

As a result, five young men—all residents of Keosauqua, were arrested. They are Eddie Keith, Ted Green, Raymond Conroy, and one whose name is not recalled. Upon questioning by the chief of police, they decided to plead not guilty. They were informed that if they would have to furnish bond on their pleas to guilty, if they so desired, and have a hearing immediately before a justice of the peace. They took the latter course.

Fall to Make Repairs. After finding each of them guilty and assessing Justice Oetel made them sign an agreement that they would repair the face of the monument. To date no steps have been taken to repair the veteran's memorial. The five was able to pay the fine at the time of trial. Knowing this to be the case, the Klansmen of today are holding their own in the political arena. The Klansmen will put their own race in the race. "An invisible struggle has been taking place between the mind of the American democracy and its instinct between the political ideal of unity that was always wanted, a unity that begins only now to be revealed in terms of the science of genetics. The immigration act of 1924 is in effect, but it is not that there is not to be assimilated; second, that in the last twenty or thirty years this rate has been enormously exceeded; third, that certain Old World races, particularly those from the east and American and less, are more alien to the North American race than the North American race itself."
Klan Is the Advance Guard
