Foreword

Since many government publications become known by short titles that appear nowhere on the piece, and since libraries catalog them under institutional titles, a device for tying the two together is needed. The present catalog is the third edition of a work the Library of Congress first issued in 1966.

Entries in this edition have been greatly expanded to include extensive annotations and other added information useful to both reference librarians and researchers. A subject index has been added to further facilitate its use.

The demand for both the earlier editions has been heavy. We hope the present one will be even more useful.

Introduction

Government reports cited by popular name may not be easily identified in library catalogs and published bibliographies. Such documents are usually indexed by corporate author, title, series, or subject, and their descriptions, which are taken directly from the documents themselves, are not likely to reflect the popular designation. A report of a congressional committee, for example, may become known by the name of the chairman, the vice chairman, a member, or a specialist on the committee staff, all of whose names may be prominently mentioned in the document. Other reports, however, bear no personal names at all, and some, regardless of their authorship or sponsorship, become known by nonpersonal names. The location of such documents may therefore prove to be a time-consuming task for the researcher and librarian.

In recognition of this problem, Donald F. Wisdom and William P. Kilroy in 1966 compiled the first edition of *Popular Names of U.S. Government Reports: A Catalog*. The work was amplified and revised in 1970 by Bernard A. Bernier, Jr., and Charlotte M. David. In the third edition, which supersedes the earlier two, extensive revisions have been made and a large number of new titles added. One example, the Gallatin report on roads and canals, dates from as early as 1808, whereas certain others, such as the Griffiths reports on public welfare, a

series, have not been published in their entirety as this work goes to press. Most of the reports are known by the name of a person prominently associated with them, but a few, such as the Pentagon Papers and the ORRRC Reports, are known by nonpersonal names. Most have been issued by the Government Printing Office or directly by the agencies which prepared them, but we have extended the scope of the catalog to include private imprints issued for a sponsoring government agency, as well as private reprints. If a report has been published in more than one edition, such as a departmental and a congressional serial edition, each is listed.

The reports are arranged alphabetically by popular name. With each entry we have provided a bibliographic description, in most cases a transcription of the Library of Congress printed card. If the card has been revised, we have given the latest edition. It will be noted that in many instances a revised card reflects the popular title; an example is the report appearing under the name of Thomas S. Gates, where a note, "Commonly known as the Gates report," and a tracing, "Gates report on an all-volunteer Armed Force," have been added. To a large extent, these revisions are based upon information appearing in earlier editions of this catalog, and it is expected that more card revisions for these reports will eventually become available.

This edition of the catalog differs most notably from its predecessors by the inclusion, where applicable, of citations to the *Checklist of United States Public Documents*, the *Document Catalog*, and the *Monthly Catalog* to assist in such further searching as may be required. Superintendent of Documents classification numbers have been cited in response to requests of many libraries that rely on this classification number for bibliographic control. An index has also been provided to facilitate the use of this catalog. Each entry is indexed by the main subject of the report. For reports cataloged under the rules for corporate bodies, a subject form of the issuing body is listed in the index for purposes of identification (e.g., U.S. Congress. House. Committee on Agriculture is indexed as Agriculture, House Committee on).

In addition, we have added a section under the heading "Impeachment Inquiry," a term which the press has used to refer to the investigation of illegal government practices during the Richard M. Nixon administration. In this section a departure was made from listing only government reports. An attempt was made to include all

reports, hearings, and miscellaneous documents printed by the Government Printing Office pertaining to the Watergate affair and related matters.

Finally, a section has been included indicating those reports for which we have minimal bibliographic information. These have come to our attention through various sources and the editors solicit any information which might lead to the document itself.

Since any U.S. government report alluded to even once by a popular name qualifies for inclusion in this catalog, it is obvious that no such bibliography could be complete. Suggestions for new entries in a future edition will be most welcome, as will any comments on the present edition.

The editors acknowledge their debt to Donnie W. Draughon, Jr., of the Exchange and Gift Division, who rendered invaluable assistance in securing the many government documents needed for review in compiling this catalog. We also wish to express our special gratitude to those librarians who have supplied us with many new titles and valuable clues to their identification.
