OAKES REPORT

Cannot identify the subject of this report issued August 9, 1865.

Issued by the Department of the Interior and entitled "Cost of the oil import program to the American economy." 1961.

PRICE REPORT [Price, Don Krasher]

Issued by the President's Task Force on Government Reorganization. 1964.

Concerns food. 1945.

Issued by the President's Commission on United States Information Operations Abroad. December 1960.

Concerns predicting tight federal budgets even after the Vietnam War ends.

Concerns the investment in natural resource science and technology and issued as a special report on science and technology and the mission of the Department of the Interior. May 18, 1967.
